2 Peter 1:20-21	The Bible is God's message to man. Men wrote the Bible as the Holy Spirit guided them.
John 8:31-32	Intellectual belief alone is not enough. True disciple is someone who holds to the teaching of Jesus. The truth will set us free.
Matthew 15:1-9	Are we following the tradition of the elders or the command of God? God wants us to follow him and obey his Word. Will you live by the Bible more than feelings, traditions, desires, etc?
Acts 17:10-12	Why were the Bereans of more noble character? Are you willing to let God's Word be the standard for your life?
James 1:22-25	Here is the Bible is likened to a mirror. Why? How should we respond to the teaching in the Bible?
John 12:48	The Word of God will judge and determine our eternal destiny.
